1. Writing for Media

This course has been introduced with 4 credit system. The need of the course is that student should be familiar with Newspaper and Magazines in Konkani. Similarly. Objectives of this course can be defined in following terms. Firstly, Students will gain knowledge of journalism and related factors. Secondly, they will learn to write for various social media platforms. Thirdly students will become aware of different media outlets and lastly students will be able to work in media house. Students will be exposed to various media outlets. Students will be able to work in the media.

Carrer prospect's: - Those students who Completed this four-credit course can work for different media houses. they can be a journalist, writer, animator, editor, content writer, advertising manager, reporter.

2. Traditional Occupations of Goa

This course has been introduced with 4 credit system. To learn this, course the students Must have a basic knowledge of the traditional occupations of Goa they must have read about different traditional occupations of Goa. Based on the objectives of this course. The outcome can be put up like this Students will be introduced to traditional occupations of goa. They will gather knowledge of traditional occupations of goa. they will





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understand that with them traditional occupations became aware of modernity in their occupations and finally to encourage traditional occupations of goa.

Carrer prospects: - Students who have studied this course will understand which occupations are in demand and will take up the occupations, which promotes our tradition and culture.

3. Event Management

This is three credit course that has been introduced under NEP 202 For Konkani Language. Pre-requisites for the Course is that students should have General knowledge of event organizing. Objectives of this course are as follows. Firstly, to let them gain knowledge of Event Management. Secondly let students know about physical planning of an event and thirdly to Understand the whole process of physical management of an event. The outcome of this course are as follows firstly to understand the entire process of operational management. Secondly to learn the skills of economic planning, thirdly to understand the role of the executive manager and lastly to understand the challenges of performance management.

4. Journalism for electronic Media

This is a four-credit course implemented under NEP for Konkani language Pre-requisites of this course are: students should be aware of different journalism courses and secondly, they should be aware different types of print media like radio, television, and online sources. The objectives of this course are first to make students think differently, secondly to make them able to write and speak effectively and thirdly to develop confidence in the students to work in this field in the future outcomes of this course are as follows, firstly, you can develop the ability to think critically, creatively, and independently. Secondly the ability to develop oneself clearly, both in writing and orally and thirdly to the ability to carry out journalistic research and interviews and lastly the ability to prepare content for news media outlets.

Carrer prospects: -After completion of this course students will acquire knowledge how journalism works for electronic media and can take up career like news Anchor, broadcasting and production for television and radio.

5. Usage of computers in Konkani

This is a 4-credit course which is combination of theory and practical component. Perquisites of this course is that students should have basic knowledge about computers. They should aware of different parts of computers. The objective of this course can be listed in three categories. First it will make students computer literate. Secondly students will learn how computer is used for language learning and development. Thirdly students full be aware of different fields of Konkani Language where we can effectively use the same.
