Transformative learning theory emphasizes the importance of transformative experiences in promoting learning and growth (Mezirow,1997)

Several studies have investigated the impact of transformative pedagogy on teacher education. A study by Villagas & Lucus (2002) Found that transformative pedagogy promoted culturally responsive teaching practices among student teachers. A Study by Gay (2010) Found that transformative pedagogy promoted critical thinking and reflection among students, teachers.

While there is a growing body of research on transformative pedagogy, there is a need for further studies on its impact on student teachers professional development and teaching practices. This study aims to address this gap in the literature.
